What is the ARAO Hotline?

The Anti-Racism Anti-Oppression Hotline is a tool for anyone to use to report racial incidents. The Hotline was created from the Black Education Act, which was passed in 2021,

The ARAO also has a response team that serves as a research and connection tool to sources of information to assist all parties with connecting and reaching solutions.

What are the **Requirements** of the Hotline?

has a few requirements that have been outlined in the legislation:

- The link to report incidents to the Hotline is accessible on the Public Education Department Website.
- The Hotline specifically created for reporting racially charged incidents and racialized aggression involving students or school personnel.
- Every school district and every charter school shall provide links to the statewide Hotline to report racially charged incidents or racial aggression.
